



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why is a new athletic complex so important?

A: The current stadium hasn't had a major upgrade in over 50 years and is simply not able to meet the needs of our students and community. The new athletic complex will allow for easier scheduling, be open for community use, increase capacity, enhance the fan experience, and boost the appeal of the district and the community.

Q: I have heard about the master plan. What other projects are included?

A: Other projects include parking lots, tennis courts, and a softball field. The new athletic complex is just the first of several projects that will fully build out our athletics facilities to support growing interest in a wide variety of sports and activities.

Q: What are the benefits of the new athletic complex?

A: First, the new athletic complex facilities will be ADA-compliant, allowing access for all students, fans, and community members.

The new athletic complex will also support growing crowds at athletic events, with more space for seating and larger restroom facilities. New locker rooms will increase space available for players, and the addition of a visitor locker room gives visiting teams private space for their athletes before and after the game and during breaks. In addition, the new athletic complex will have safe passage from the locker rooms to the field.

The addition of a turf field will eliminate weather-related scheduling issues and require less maintenance than our current grass fields.

Finally, the project will enhance the appeal of the district and the community to current and prospective residents.

Q: Why turf?

A: Turf fields can take more use, and having one field for multiple teams is less expensive than maintaining multiple fields.

Some studies suggest that turf reduces injuries.

Turf doesn't have the seasonal limitations that grass fields do. No more waiting for our grass fields to dry in the spring.

Turf allows more teams to play at the same time through scheduling efficiencies.

Ways to Give

A: Yes. One hundred percent of all donations to the capital campaign

will be allocated to the new athletic complex project. The Donegal Athletic Club raises money for organizational and administrative costs through an annual golf tournament, a silent auction, and membership dues separately from this effort.

Q: Is the Donegal School District Board of Education supportive of the capital campaign?

A: Yes. Donegal Athletic Club, although independent, is working closely with the school board to help support the project.

Q: Is my gift to the Donegal capital campaign taxdeductible?

A: Yes. The Donegal Athletic Club is registered as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. Gifts to the capital campaign are taxdeductible up to the amount outlined by IRS regulations for charitable deductions.

Q: Why should I contribute to the capital campaign when I already pay school taxes?

A: Donegal Athletic Club is working to fund this project and other endeavors, in part to ease the burden on the district and ultimately, tax payers. In addition, the project is designed to eliminate the need for ongoing, costly repairs for existing facilities that will continue to deteriorate.

Q: My child is enrolled in Donegal School District but isn't involved in sports or the band. Why should I donate?

A: The facility will be utilized by all students for physical education instruction and school-wide events like commencement, and will give them a better fan experience as they support their classmates on the field. Additionally, the complex will be open to other members of your family for activities such as youth sports leagues, community-wide events, and personal fitness and recreation use.
